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SHAPING LIGHT, SCULPTING ART



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
A VISION.

art and illumination.











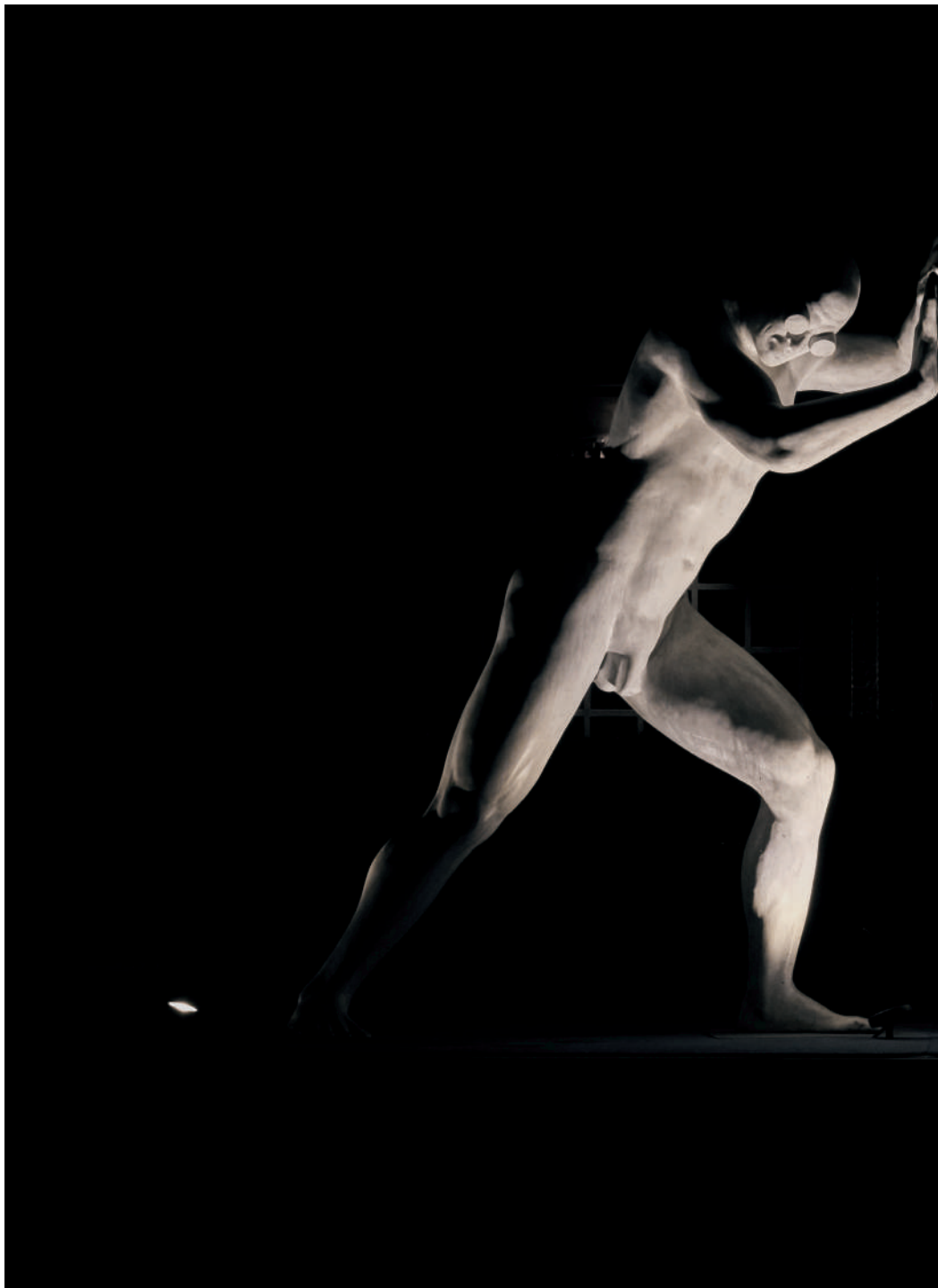


“Shaping light, sculpting art”

and transforms.















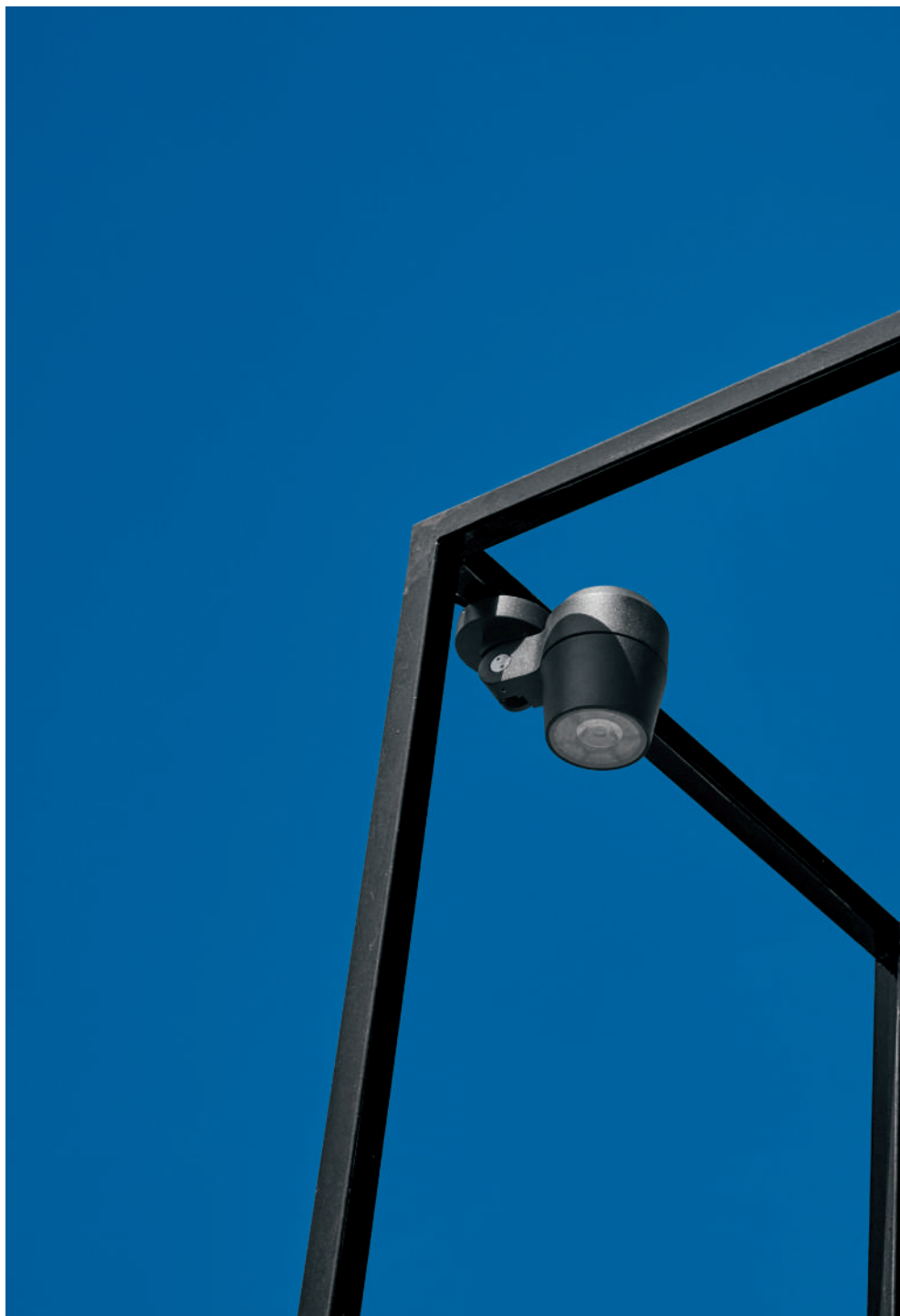




Light is never neutral.

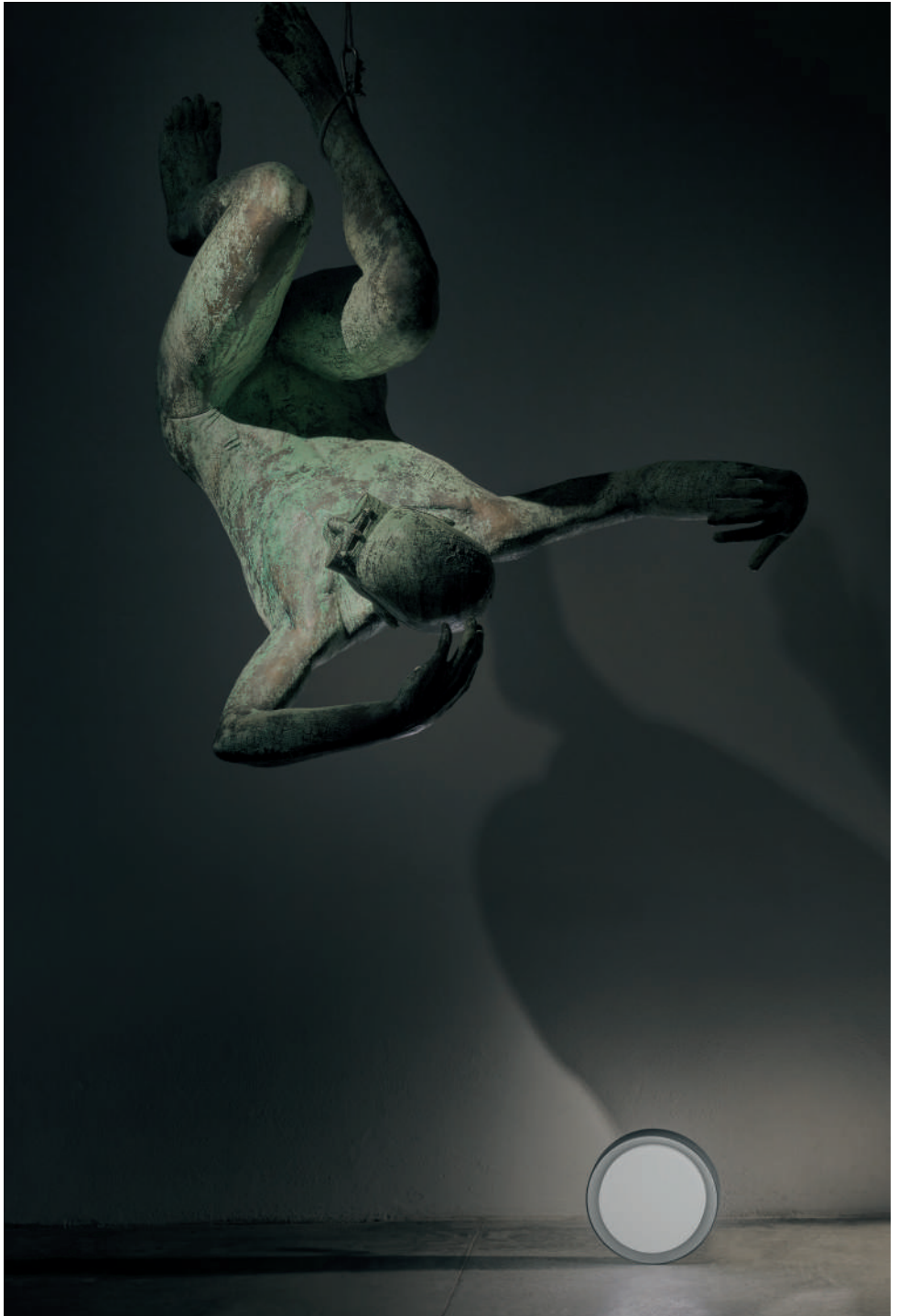












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
